Father Steve Coffey, OSB.cam will facilitate this retreat which will be based on the spirituality of Julian of Norwich. Julian was a 14th century anchoress and English mystic who wrote only one book, The Revelations of Divine Love. It is the first known book in the English language written by a woman and consists of her reflections and meditations on a series of visions she had of Jesus’ passion and what He shared with her. Julian is especially remembered for her maternal images of God and her deep trust in God’s providential love and care.

This retreat is for people of all walks of life—clergy, religious and lay people who long for a deep, personal experience of God’s love and presence, and who feel drawn to an extended conversation with the Lord. The daily schedule is arranged to give you maximum unencumbered time for prayer, along with daily Eucharist and several optional communal activities.
